M. Phil. (Sanskrit) Scheme of Examination (w.e.f Session 2015-16)

The duration of M. Phil. course will be one and a half years (three semesters). There will be three papers each, in 1st & 2^{nd} Semesters and dissertation in the 3^{rd} Semester. Each theory paper will carry 80 marks and will be divided into four units bearing 20 marks each. There will be an internal assessment of 20 marks in each theory paper. For internal assessment the students are required to present two assignments and one seminar in each theory paper. The dissertation will be of 200 marks (150+50).

Note- Syllabus for PhD coursework will be same as in M. Phil. 1stSemester.
