TENDER NOTICE

Sealed tenders super-scribed as “**Tender for Sculptures**” addressed to the Registrar, M. D. University, Rohtak are invited from reputed firms/Sculptors for the fabrication & supply of one each Life size, Standing Bronze Sculptures of Swami Vivekanand, Rabindra Nath Tagore and Maharshi Dayanand (7’-6” each) with proportionate width –(Layer thickness upper body 4mm and lower 7mm), alongwith prescribed earnest money equal to 2% of the involved value of quoted items in the shape of a Demand Draft in favour of Finance Officer, M.D.U Rohtak latest by **12.05.2008**. Tenderers may also enclose their preferred photos to be used for casting the sculptures. Tender Notice, containing detailed terms and conditions of supply, may be had from the office of the Executive Engineer, MDU, Rohtak on any working day or may be downloaded from the University website **www mdurohtak.com**. Tenders will be opened on **13.05.2008 at 11.00 a.m.** in the office of the Registrar in the presence of representative(s) of firm(s)/Sculptors who- so-ever will be present. Negotiations, if necessary, will be held on the same day.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE TENDERS FOR THE FABRI- CATION AND SUPPLY OF BRONZE SCULPTURES.

1. Tender shall be accompanied by the earnest money equal to 2% of the involved Value. The money should be deposited through Bank draft in favour of Finance Officer, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, payable at the State Bank of India, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak.
2. The tender received without earnest money, or after the due date shall not be entertained except with the special approval of the Registrar.
3. Supply shall be executed within the time specified in the supply order which may be extended by the Registrar on the application of the supplier explaining reasons/circumstances due to which time limit could not be adhered to. In the event of the supplier failing to supply the material with in time, he shall be liable to pay as compensation an amount equal to one percent or such small amount as the Registrar may decide on the said amount of the contract, for every day that the quantity remains incomplete, provided that the entire amount of compensation shall not exceed 10 percent of the total amount of contract. An appeal against these orders shall however lie with the Vice-Chancellor whose decision shall be final.
4. In case the contractor backs out of his contract, the earnest money deposited by him shall be forfeited besides any other action as may be considered necessary by the Vice-Chancellor.
5. All the charges including packing, forwarding and installation, taxes and other levies should be specified in the tender. The charges etc. not specified in the tender shall not be paid.
6. Supply shall be made as per the schedule and within such time as is indicated in the supply order.
7. 100 % payment will be made on receipt and inspection of goods or as per mutual agreement.
8. The Rates accepted by the University shall be applicable upto 90 days.
9. The tenders shall be opened by the Committee in the presence of Sculptors/supplier /their representative(s) who-so-ever is present. Negotiations, if necessary, shall also take place on the same day.
10. Requisition to be fulfilled by the University for installation of sculptures must also be specified.
11. The Registrar reserves the right to reject or accept any offer without assigning any reason.
12. All disputes subject to Rohtak jurisdiction.
13. All the other terms and conditions can be seen /obtained from the office of Executive Engineer, MDU, Rohtak on any working day during office hours as well as on University Web Site www.mdurohtak.com
