The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, M. D. University will be holding Walk-in-Interview for the University Grants Commission awarded UGC-BSR Research Fellowships for the academic session 2014-15 with the purpose of providing opportunities to meritorious students to undertake research leading to Ph.D. degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences.

Scholarship Details:

Tenure: The tenure of fellowship is initially for two years extendable for a further period of three years on the basis of the research work of the first two years.

Nature of Assistance:

Fellowship and HRA as per UGC rules

Total No. of fellowships: 05 (Five) under UGC-BSR.

Eligibility Criteria:

Qualified M.Pharm. Candidates who are eligible for registration to Ph.D. Programme (Candidates who qualified prePh.D. in Pharmaceutical Sciences from MDU / who are pursuing PhD course work in Pharmaceutical Sciences at MDU) in the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak can apply.

Other conditions: As per UGC Rules

Cancellation of award of fellowship: Fellowship is liable to cancellation in case of i) Misconduct, ii) Unsatisfactory progress of research work/failure in any examination related to Ph. D. or iii) Fellow is found ineligible later.
