- Abstracts must be submitted by February 10, 2012.
- Authors of accepted abstracts will be asked to submit full papers after presentation in the Seminar.
- The contributor should certify that the manuscript is his /her original contribution. It should be mentioned that the paper has not been submitted or accepted for publication any where else. The authors shall be responsible for the facts and opinion made by them.
