## Overview

The Hospitality and Tourism Industry is enjoying continued positive growth over decades to become one of the fastest growing economic sectors in the world. Apart from importance, its contribution has outshined the oil export, in volume, to become a major player in international commerce. This has produced enormous economic and employment benefits for the local population especially for developing countries like India. The Industry provides employment to people ranging from highly skilled to unskilled. Globally, the industry provides job to 277 million people. A report published by WTTC, exhibited that for India, in 2016, the industry directly supported 23,454,500 jobs (5.5% of total employment) and this is further expected to rise by 1.9% in 2015 and rise by 2.2% pa to 29,629,000 jobs (5.8% of total employment) in 2026. Now days, young people prefer this industry as a career choice over traditional professions. The same has been recognised by the Government of India, so as to impart quality training, the Govt. has started the Hospitality & Tourism programmes under National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).
