About the Sir Chhotu Ram Chair

The Sir Chhotu Ram Chair was established by government of Haryana in the year 1992 at Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak in the honour of Deenbandhu Sir Chhotu Ram. The aims and objectives of the Chair was to explore the fields relevant to the philosophy of Sir Chhotu Ram and his contribution towards these fields. There are many instances, which represent his value for education and compassion for the downtrodden. His efforts led to the socio-economic prosperity of the regions with agricultural development and military recruitment.

Sir Chhotu Ram led a massive recruitment drive for the army during World War-I in the Modern Haryana Region and during World War-II across pre-partition Punjab. His support of the British War efforts is often seen as a controversial step as the Congress had given a call not to provide any help to the British. He actively promoted recruitment of Jats in particular and other forming communities in general in the army as he felt it was economically beneficial to these communities. The recurring theme of his campaigns was India's independence after the war. He said, "My hope is that after this war Hindustan will be free. And it will be free in a real sense."

The founding Chair Professor of the Chair was Dr. Satbir Singh, Professor of Psychology who came from G.N.D. University, Amritsar. Since its inception number of lecture series and seminars have been organized by various incharge Professors of this Chair.

About the Seminar

The domestication of plants and animals led to the beginning of most indispensible economic activity of mankind called farming/agriculture. Agriculture began independently in different parts of the world.

Agriculture is the backbone of any country. For example, the major population of India is working as farmers accounting for around 16% of the total G.D.P. There is no doubt that agriculture plays a crucial role in the overall growth of any country. So, it is necessary to ensure its development.
