About the Department

Two years after the establishment of the University (1976), the sociology department was established (1978) with staff strength of one Reader (Dr. S.K.Chauhan) and two lecturers (Dr. B.K.Nagla and Dr. K.S. Sangwan). Subsequently, number of teaching faculty has increased. At present the department has four Professors, one Assistant Professor. The department has approved three programmes of studies namely, M.A., M.Phil and Ph.D. In the beginning, the department started with M.A. Programme. Subsequently, M.Phil was introduced in 1988. The faculty members have been quite active in the academic front as can be inferred from their publications and other academic assignments. Teachers of the department are also involved in the several projects and community oriented programmes by way of acting as resource person in National Literacy Mission Project, providing consultancy in other useful programmes at the State and National level such as Adult Literacy, Prohibition, Drug Addiction, Population and Reproductive Health Care, Welfare of Scheduled Castes and other Backward Castes Commission. The teachers are frequently attending national and international conferences and seminars. The field-work based research assignments has been the constant feature of the department. Under this programme students are taken to the rural and urban areas in different socio-cultural milieu both in Haryana as well as outside Haryana to give wide exposure to the students of M.A. It encourages them to pursue their research interests. The department has invited several scholars for extension lectures and also as visiting fellow, visiting professor under the UGC scheme. The department has organized number of National Seminars on topics such as: Social Transformation, Dynamics of Indian Society and Women and Human Rights in India. In the year 2015, the department was awarded Special Assistance programme DRS Phase-III for the period of five years w.e.f. 2013-18.

• The vision of the department is to have teaching, learning and research at its optimal level which in turn results in the overall development of society at intellectual, social, cultural and economic level.

- The Department is continue to strive towards excellence in teaching and research.

- In our department, because of the heavy teaching load, the faculty members are not sufficiently able to dedicate themselves in research activities in terms of projects.
- Lack of Government efforts in introducing Sociology at college and school level.

Opportunities

- The department is capable to take benefit of opportunities available to faculty in terms of attending seminars, conferences, workshops at regional, national and international level.
- The faculty is also called for Selection Committee meetings, Board of Studies meeting, Departmental Research Committee meeting, Ph.D evaluation and viva-voce and also for invited lectures, inaugural lectures and valedictory lectures in seminars and conferences.
- Employment Opportunities are also available in NCR which student take advantage of it.
- Enhanced focus of government on research regarding policy-centric issues.

Challenges

- Challenges are directly related to the sustainability of the subject in terms of providing knowledge, employment and competition for imparting education in comparison to others.
- Sociology subject is in huge demand and Department of Sociology is also in demand as we receive large number of applications of students. However, there is 30 to 40 per cent dropout in post-graduation course.
- Another challenge lies in improving the communication skill of the students so that they can be well placed.

Session 2019-20

- ✓ Department will focus on experimental learning by inviting experienced professional and providing access to students to have qualitative instructional material.
- ✓ Empower faculty about emerging trend in the profession for academic advancement.
- ✓ To motivate students and teaches to undertake research activities such as preparation of projects, publication of research papers in reputed journals.
- ✓ To encourage students and teachers to participate in seminars/workshops/conferences/symposia at regional, national and international level.
- ✓ Considering the environment responsibilities, the Department will focus towards sustainability of environment by encouraging public transport, use of bicycles and elimination of use of plastic at all levels.
