REPORT OF ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY YOUTH RED CROSS M.D. UNIVERSITY ROHTAK FROM 01.08.2017 to 31.07.2018

1. Meeting of University Youth Red Cross Committee M.D. University Rohtak
